Our electronics are filled with resources that can be recovered and put back into the manufacturing supply chain. Recycling through EPRA/Recycle My Electronics authorized drop-off locations ensures that devices are diverted from landfill and recycled responsibly for sustainable material recovery.

Accessible for residents and businesses

Recycle My Electronics programs have a network of over 80 collection locations throughout New Brunswick, including return-to-retail locations and authorized drop-off points. Just enter your postal code or town into the map locator, when you visit recycleMYelectronics.ca/NB
