Designated experiences receive enhanced marketing exposure, trusted third-party validation, and greater visibility across provincial tourism channels, helping build confidence and convert interest into bookings.

Eligible experiences must be TAP approved, operating for at least one year, and demonstrate consistency, authenticity, safety, and a clear "wow" moment for guests.

The Exceptional Experience designation applies to a specific tourism experience offered by a business or organization. It is not a designation of the business, operation, or organization as a whole.

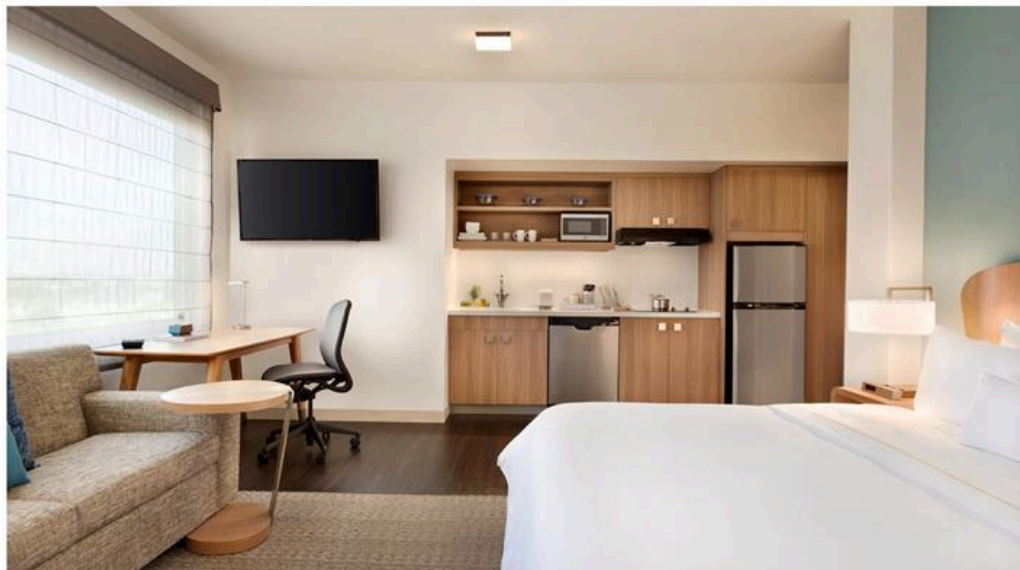

The Electronic Products Recycling Association (EPRA) is an industry-led, not-for-profit that manages the only government-approved end-of-life electronics recycling program in the province.

Our program includes electronic devices and small appliances such as:

- Radios and clocks
- Laptops, tablets, and computers
- Irons and hair dryers
- Printers and copiers
- Microwaves and coffee makers
- Keyboards, mice and cables
- Toasters and tea kettles
- Chargers and docking stations
- Displays and TVs
